C. Sample multiple choice questions—one for *each* subsection, with answer choices and the correct answer listed.

You are welcome to make up your own questions or find them from elsewhere.

Suggestion #2: Ask Mr. Bigler for your old tests from earlier in the year and use questions from them.

D. Sample open response question—one essay or problem that covers *one or more* of the subtopics listed in the frameworks. Problems must include the correct answer. Essays must include all of the correct answers, though they can be in outline or bullet form—you don’t need to write out the actual essay.
